- SYO has a new website (address on front) with its own members' section. Many thanks to Ben for his hard work.

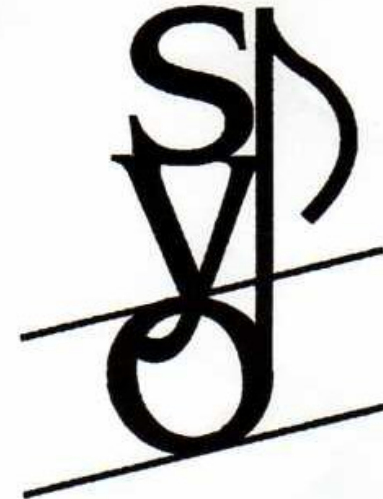
Upcoming Concerts:
